- It was agreed that all classes should use green refuse bags to throw away used plastic and paper. It was also pointed out that all recyclable material should be clean.
- Green refuse bags that have been filled, are to be put outside the classroom door every Monday afternoon so as to be collected by the caretakers. On Tuesdays, these bags will be collected and taken to the waste treatment plant.
