

Minutes: 15th October 2013

The persons who attended this meeting were, Ms Napier (Assistant Head), Ms Piscopo (year 1 teacher), Ms Coreschi (LSA) and Mr Gatt (*EkoSkola Officer, LEAF National Co-Ordinator*). The following issues were discussed:

- During this scholastic year, all classes should participate in at least one educational outing related to an ecological theme.
- As a follow up to this educational outing, the pupils together with their class teacher could prepare a presentation that explains what went on and what was learnt during the outing. These presentations could then be delivered during the morning assembly.
- The school is still going to put an emphasis on **reducing, reusing and recycling**. This scholastic year's theme for the Book Week is going to focus on recycling.
- An effort to include *Catch the Drop* in the EkoSkola Action Plan will be made. The SMT will also be consulted about the setting up of a reservoir in which rain water could be collected. This water could then be utilised for cleaning floors, for watering plants and for water play activities.
- It was suggested that water hippos should be inserted in toilet flushings to save water.
- The first meeting with the new EkoSkola Committee is going to be held on the 8th of November.
- Another meeting is going to be held on the 11th of November. The persons who are going to be invited for this meeting will be: The EkoSkola Committee; Mr Johann Gatt and representatives from the Zabbar Local Council.
