Mr A. Debattista, the Head of School was present during this meeting. The following issues were discussed:

- **Catch the Drop Campaign** - Rain water is going to be collected in specially designed water tanks. This rainwater will then be used for water play, to clean floors and to water the plants. HSBC is going to provide the funds for the equipment needed.
- **Water hippos** - These will be inserted in toilet flushings so as to reduce water consumption. The SMT will ask the school handyman to assist during these projects.
- Water consumption will be monitored
- **Eco Wardens** - These will be introduced in our school and they will monitor water consumption during break time.
- Eco School Committee members are going to be given specifically designed tags.
- **Book Week** - During the book week the teachers will be making use of recycled material. Photos of these displays/props will be taken as an example of good practice.
- Teachers will be encouraged to produce lesson plans/crafts where recycled material was used. They will also encourage pupils to reduce water consumption.
- The school is going to apply for the Green Flag.

- During SDP meetings the staff will be encouraged to make use of their own personal mugs. To reduce the amount of waste generated by the school the use of plastic and polystyrene disposable mugs will not be encouraged. During the Christmas Party the children will also be encouraged to make use of plastic reusable plates.
- The committee suggested outings for children and parents to Waste Serv Malta. These outings will be planned for the 2nd and 3rd semesters.
- An activity will be organised for parents. During this activity the parents will be invited to make use of recycled materials to make Christmas bags, wrapping paper and cards.
