

Hansel and Gretel craft

Things you need:

coloured papers, pictures of sweets, scissors, glue, paper bag

Look for pictures of sweets from magazines, adverts or junk mail.

You may help (or ask) children to cut pictures of sweets or cut coloured papers into different shapes similar to sweets.



Use an A4 paper and ask children to draw a house and decorate the house with the pictures or shapes.



You may use a paper bag and ask children to decorate it with sweets or pictures.



Look at the final craft. Discuss with your child:

How many sweets did we use? What shape are the sweets? What colour are the sweets? Would you live in a house made out of sweets? Why?
